

USDBF Outrigger safety and usage suggestions

- 1. Careful handling of the boat is required for the privilege of use
- 2. Any damage noted whether you caused it or not must be reported to the team equipment manager
- 3. You must follow any rules of boating safety for the body of water you will paddle on.
- 4. After dark lights must be worn, only veterans can paddle after dark.
- 5. A spare paddle is a good idea.
- 6. In general, even experienced OC1 paddlers should paddle with a friend
- 7. If straying far from shore a communication device should be on board.

Novice and Youth Issues

- 8. Prior to use a veteran must instruct you on righting and re-boarding procedures after a flip and general boat handling and safety.
- 9. Novices and youth must wear a life jacket while paddling.
- 10. Novices and youth are not permitted to go out without an adult veteran. There needs to be one adult for every 2 novices or youth.
- 11. Novices and youth will not paddle in cold weather, high water or rough conditions even if with a veteran. Novices and youth should generally stay close to the banks or shore when paddling.
- 12. Novices and youth may not paddle in the dark.
- 13. Novices and youth must have two persons carry the boat into and out of the water.
